PREFACE.

From 1859 to March 1873 the Proceedings relating to Road and Public Works Cesses were intermixed with those of the Land Revenue Branch, and from April 1873 to December 1878, they were dealt with as forming a separate branch of the Revenue Department; but from January 1879 to July 1910 the Road and Public Works Cess branch was placed under the control of the Financial Department, and the Proceedings relating thereto were included in the monthly proceedings volumes of that Department. Again in July 1910, this branch was transferred to the control of the Revenue Department, and the connected proceedings have been treated as a separate subject in the monthly proceedings volumes of the Land Revenue branch with effect from January 1911.

This volume does not include the B cases, the records of which have already been destroyed, nor does it include the proceedings of the late Government of Eastern Bengal and Assam from October 1905 to December 1908.
